

Student Dress Code

Purpose:

The purpose of the Student Dress Code is to outline Cranbourne Carlisle Primary School's requirements for student dress and appearance and to provide information about uniform purchase and support, dress code implementation and exemption processes.

This dress code has been developed by Cranbourne Carlisle Primary School's School Council in close consultation with our school community to ensure that it respects the rights of individual children whilst reflecting the values and interests of our community.

The Student Dress Code aims to:

- foster a sense of community and belonging and encourages children to develop pride in their appearance
- support Cranbourne Carlisle Primary School's commitment to ensuring that our children feel equal and are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities.
- reduce competition on the basis of clothing
- enhance the profile and identity of the school and its children within the wider community.

The School Council has developed a dress code that we believe provides a range of choices for children and is cost effective for families.

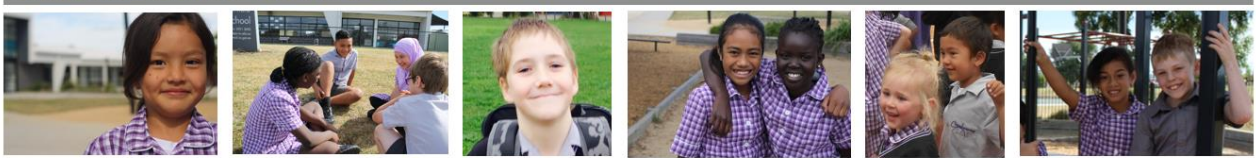
Scope:

Children are expected to comply with this Student Dress Code while traveling to and from school, during school hours and when attending school activities.

Implementation:

- Summer and winter uniforms, as well as sports uniforms will be prescribed, and are required to be worn. Correct summer uniform is to be worn in Terms One and Four each year. Correct winter uniform is to be worn in Terms Two and Three. Both uniforms have the capacity to cater for the temperatures between seasons.
- Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the lower earlobe are the only acceptable jewellery. Watches are permissible upon parent approval. No responsibility is accepted by the school. Wearable devices, such as smart watches, are not to come to school.
- Extreme hair colors (eg: green, pink or purple rinses, etc.) and/or extreme hairstyles (eg: spikes, mohawks, chisel cutting, etc.) are not permitted.
- Cosmetics may not be worn at school. Only clear nail polish may be worn.
- The only hat that is acceptable is the purple school hat, consistent with our Sunsmart policy. The hat must be worn outside in Terms One and Four. Hats are not to be worn inside. It is advisable to have two hats to ensure they are regularly laundered, etc.
- Headwear worn for religious or cultural purposes and hair accessories, such as scrunchies, ribbons or headbands, must be black, white, grey or purple.
- Additional layers of clothing may be worn underneath the uniform for added warmth, provided that they are in school colours.
- Details of uniform items, prices and places of purchase are available at the School Office
- School Council requires the Principal be responsible for implementation of the dress code in a manner consistent with the Student Code of Conduct.
- Arrangements can be made with State Schools Relief to assist families experiencing economic hardship.
- Parents seeking exemptions to the dress code due to religious beliefs, ethnic or cultural background, student disability, health condition or economic hardship must apply in writing to the School Council for consideration.

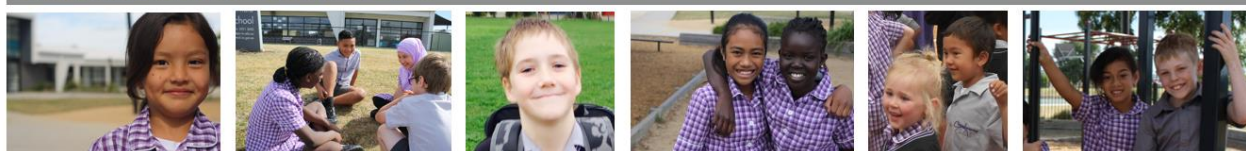

Uniform Requirements

<u>SUMMER UNIFORM – TERMS 1 and 4</u>	
<p><u>Boys</u> Short sleeve grey shirt with school logo Grey shorts Black windcheater with school logo School hat with school logo Grey, white or black socks Black shoes Any visible underclothes, such as long sleeve t-shirts are to be grey, white or black</p> <p><i>Boys who wear any form of head covering for religious purposes must ensure that they are black, grey, white or purple</i></p>	<p><u>Girls</u> Purple and white checked blouse Purple and white check culottes Black windcheater with school logo School hat with school logo Grey, white or black socks Black shoes Any visible underclothes, such as long sleeve t-shirts, tights or leggings are to be grey, white or black</p> <p><i>Girls who wear any form of head covering for religious purposes must ensure that they are black, grey, white or purple</i></p>
<u>WINTER UNIFORM – TERMS 2 and 3</u>	
<p><u>Boys</u> Long sleeve grey shirt with school logo Grey trousers Black windcheater with school logo Grey, white or black socks Black shoes Black beanie with school logo (optional) Any visible underclothes, such as long sleeve t-shirts, tights or leggings are to be grey, white or black</p> <p><i>Boys who wear any form of head covering for religious purposes must ensure that they are black, grey, white or purple</i></p>	<p><u>Girls</u> Grey box pleat tunic OR grey box pleat skirt OR unisex pleated trousers White long sleeve shirt Black windcheater with school logo Grey, white or black socks Black shoes Black beanie with school logo (optional) Any visible underclothes, such as long sleeve t-shirts, tights or leggings are to be grey, white or black</p> <p><i>Girls who wear any form of head covering for religious purposes must ensure that they are black, grey, white or purple</i></p>
<u>UNISEX SPORTS UNIFORM</u>	
<p>These items are to be worn to school on days when children have scheduled physical education classes and for sport-specific days:</p> <p>Purple polo shirt with logo Black microfibre shorts OR Black tracksuit pants Black windcheater with school logo</p> <p>Any visible underclothes, such as long sleeve t-shirts, tights or leggings are to be grey, white or black</p>	
<u>OTHER CONSIDERATIONS</u>	
<p>Shoes must be black with black laces Watches are acceptable at parent's discretion. No responsibility will be taken by the school. Wearable devices, such as smart watches, are not to come to school. Earrings should be sleepers or small studs. No other jewellery is to be worn. Hair is to be neat and tidy. Long hair must be tied back. Hair accessories must be school colours. Extreme hair colors (eg: green, pink or purple rinses, etc.) and/or extreme hairstyles (eg: spikes, mohawks, chisel cutting, etc.) are not permitted. Cosmetics are not permitted. Only clear nail polish is permitted.</p>
